Overview

Situated on a historic 10.5-acre campus in Salem is the Oregon Department of Forestry's 52,960 sq ft headquarters building. The structure, built to house operations and public services offices, was designed to be compatible with the existing State Forester's Office and surrounding grounds and stone walls that are listed on the National Register of Historic Places. In some places, materials were salvaged from existing buildings for use on the new structures. Because of the sustainable and ecological design, the structure earned a Silver LEED Certification from the U.S. Green Building Council.
