Kidz First Children's Hospital

Overview

The project comprises extensive redevelopment of the existing Middlemore Hospital and expansion of the Manukau Superclinic facility.

Kidz First Children's Hospital: Incorporating general wards, support facilities and pharmacy. This is a new four level building of 7000 m² overall.

Acute Hub: Incorporating emergency department, ICU and staff centre. This is a new three level building of 10,000 m².

Adult Inpatient Centre: Incorporating wards, renal centre and CATH lab. This is a new four level building of 9000 m².

Galbraith Ward: Upgrade incorporating medical ward. This is a complete refurbishment of an existing ward of 730 m².

Laboratory comprising 1300 m² of new building and retrofit of existing space. The project also includes new energy centre, upgrading of infrastructure and extension of parking areas.
