#### Overview

A multiple-mast, cable-stay “tensegrity” design pedestrian and cycle bridge across the Brisbane River between Tank Street in the City and the new Queensland Gallery of Modern Art and State Library on the South Bank. On the North Bank, the bridge will link with Brisbane Transit Centre, Roma Street Station, State and Federal court buildings, Queensland Place and Roma Street Parkland.
