Rider Levett Bucknall's work on Wembley National Stadium began in late 1999. Our appointment as Project Monitors has seen us directly involved in some of the most intensive periods, (both good and bad), of the project history, from the initial procurement, through the Government review headed by Patrick Carter, the select committee hearing and most recently, seeing the project through to financial close.

Our initial appointment was to ensure the lottery grant provided by Sport England was being utilised in accordance with the criteria laid out in the Lottery Funding Agreement. However, the last 2 years has seen our involvement in the scheme grow significantly in terms of remit and responsibilities.
